ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must have participated in swimming or water polo (as a competitor or coach) with the Nanaimo White Rapids Swim Club for a minimum of the three (3) years (excluding 2020 COVID year). In addition, it should be his/her intention to participate with the Nanaimo White Rapids Swim Club in the summer of their graduating year. The scholarship is available to a graduating student attending any senior secondary school in the Nanaimo / Ladysmith district.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

Before funds are released, proof of registration from a post-secondary institution is required. The time period in which the applicant has to verify registration is (16) sixteen months after the award presentation. If for any reason a recipient is unable to complete the qualifications within the (16) sixteen month period, the money reverts back to the club. There will be no alternate recipients.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

1. Complete this Application Form.
2. Write a letter stating intentions in furthering education and involvement with swimming.
3. Obtain 2 letters of reference or recommendation (one school and one community).
4. Submit your application and letters to your school counsellor prior to the deadline.

Application must be submitted along with General Application to your school representative.
